Puzzle tidy™

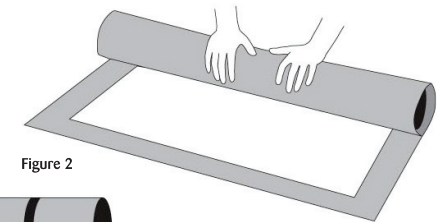
